But how do we embed this approach into everyday practice?

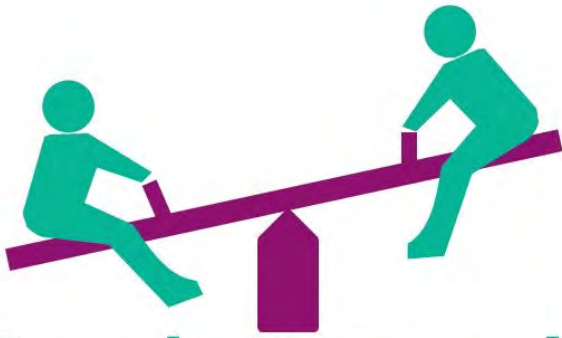

- practitioners from person centred care improvement teams who want to explore how asset mapping can support personal outcomes approaches and co-production
- community members, volunteers and peer workers who want to learn/share skills in community connecting
- anyone whose role involves connecting people with groups, informal supports and services that could support them
- people with an interest in co-production, asset based community development and community engagement.
